Upper Room Housing Facts

Applying for Residency

- 1. You must fill out an application to qualify for the Upper Room. This may be found at upperroomrecovery.org under the Recovery tab.
- 2. Send the completed application to info@upperroomrecovery.org.
- 3. The person that sent the application will receive a letter of acceptance or denial.
 - a. If denied, you will be given a reason.
 - b. If accepted, you must call 574-904-4957 immediately to either claim your name on the wait list or schedule a day and time to arrive if a bed is available.

We do not:

- Provide transportation of any kind. We are located on the bus line.
- Have access to any food. The First United Methodist Church (on-site) offers a Soup Kitchen on Mondays/Wednesdays/Fridays from 11:30am-12:30pm and a Food Pantry on Tuesdays from 10am-1pm.
- Have clothing.
- Offer toiletries.

We do offer:

- Bedding
- Bath towels
- A Recovery Café with computers and referral services.

Housing Requirements:

- You will be placed on a 14-day restriction once you arrive. The only exceptions to this
 restriction are going to work and substance use disorder and/or mental health
 treatment.
- Attend an assessment and all treatment recommendations are required.
- Pay \$100 weekly for rent or file proper paperwork for financial assistance approved by the State of Indiana Department of Mental Health and Addiction.
